



Mentor Criteria

To become a mentor as part of the KSS LC Mentoring Network, applicants must fulfil the following criteria:

Criteria	Yes/No
Mentors should have attended the KSS LC Mentoring Development Skills training day. Alternatively the KSS LC are happy to consider other training programmes, however acceptance is at the discretion of the Collaborative;	
Have a well maintained learning log and portfolio of evidence for their mentoring, including certificates of accredited qualification(s);	
Have evidence of CPD and supervision within the last 3 years or demonstrate willingness to attend a minimum of two CPD and two supervision sessions each year. Blended learning approaches are acceptable;	
Have experience of being mentored as well as mentoring others;	

KSS LC asks Mentors to commit to:

- Three mentoring relationships of 4-6 sessions each year (This is on the proviso that the mentor is requested)
- Attend two supervision sessions a year (these can be individual or group)
- Attend two CPD events a year commissioned by KSS LC
